1 TRANSITION PLAN

Implementation of the new IAP and AAPEI Appendix B

July 1, 2020

Transition Details

- a) Interns who have not submitted hours for approval by July 1, 2020 will automatically transition to the new IAP.
- b) Interns who have submitted hours which have been approved by the AAPEI have the option to enter the new IAP at any time between July 1, 2020 and July 1, 2022.
- c) Interns who are enrolled in the current IAP program will have until June 30, 2022 to complete all their IAP requirements at which time they will automatically transition into the new IAP.

2 ROLE OF ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS FOR STUDENT EXPERIENCE

On the Declaration Form provided with the AAPEI Student application form, students must have confirmation from their university that they have completed 60 credit hours in courses that contribute to the Student Performance Criteria (SPCs) for accreditation (typically during the final two years). This completed Declaration Form must be submitted with the Students first employment block.

3 STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

- a) Students must enroll/register in the jurisdiction in which they intend to undertake their internship.
- b) Students must ensure that their CERB is complete and submitted at the end of every employment block.

4 CANADIAN EXPERIENCE RECORD BOOK (CERB)

- a) Students and Interns must use the CERB form provided by the AAPEI. No other modified version will be accepted.
- b) Interns must submit their CERB as outlined in the IAP manual.

5 INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE

Recognition of any experience gained outside of Canada is addressed in AAPEI Appendix B.
